#448-20 Amendment to Newton Zoning Ordinances Chap. 30 Sec. 3.4 Garages

<u>COUNCILOR CROSSLEY</u>, on behalf of the Zoning & Planning Committee requesting amendment to provisions of Chapter 30, City of Newton Zoning Ordinances, regulating garages in residential zoning districts by revising Sec. 3.4.3.A, deleting Sec. 3.4.4 (Ordinance No. A-78) in its entirety, and inserting a new Sec. 3.4.4. The objectives of the amendment are to prevent garages from dominating the streetscape, improve safety along the public way for all modes of travel and achieve consistency with climate action goals.
